QUORUM:

Ms. McCord called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and determined there was a quorum with at least one member of the minority party being present.

WELCOME GUESTS:

Amy Sullivan, Stephen Feryus, Maggie Mundle, Virginia Green, and Rich Siejack from the staff were present for the meeting. Cassandra Beverley, Carol Bruce, Lee Mundle, Phil Hunter, Jim Thornton, Adam Nybczyuso, Mustafa Sidia, Janis Katsu, Jason Fontelieu, Jacob Bennett, Josh Koziol, and Kayla Mariskanish were also in attendance.

Mr. Thornton had requested to address the board and was granted two minutes to speak. Mr. Thornton spoke as a private citizen explaining the process of the current text and map from the Council. He stated that this was sloppy work from the Council. He cited a letter from February 24, 2022, that expressed regret that the text and map did not match but it is the map and not the text that is the representation of the Council. Mr. Thornton requested the Board of Elections to consider that only a letter came from the County Council President, but no meeting occurred. Mr. Thornton was unable to finish his comments due to his two-minute time limit.

BOARD ATTORNEY'S REPORT:

Mr. Young discussed two letters he addressed to Ms. McCord dated March 1, 2022, and March 2, 2022, regarding the 2022 Harford County Redistricting of Councilmanic Districts. He went over the timeline beginning with the BOE being tasked with the implementation of redistricting, reviewing the statute, and realizing that the map and text differed. The staff then prepared a chart with discrepancies (Memo-Issues Discovered in Bill No. 21-025 As Amended) and Mr.

Young prepared maps to show the issues. Mr. Young proceeded by explaining there are many redistricting cases but none such as this. He introduced a letter from Ms. McCord, President, Harford County Board of Elections, to County Council President Patrick Vincenti on February 24, 2022, requesting clarification and any corrections to assist in implementing the map. Mr. Vincenti replied February 24, 2022 with a letter explaining that the map, and not the text creates the boundaries of the Council districts. Mr. Young described the mechanism used by the Council, www.davesredistricting.org. He also introduced a series of emails from the County Council regarding the implementation of the map between the Council and the Harford County Department of Planning and Zoning. Mr. Young said changes were made to the map and these changes shows the Council intended the map to be what they expressed.

Mr. Richardson asked Mr. Young to discuss the letter from April Ishak, Attorney for the City of Havre de Grace. Mr. Young explained that the map is not an attachment but rather an integral part of the bill.

Mr. Campbell asked if there was a way for the Council to correct the text error. Mr. Young explained the Council cannot make an amendment after the map has been approved.

Mr. Campbell also asked if this would absolve any lawsuit against the BOE. Mr. Young expressed that the BOE has done its due diligence and that all bases have been covered.

Mr. Richardson made a motion for the Board to use the map as drawn and Mr. Price seconded the motion. All members were in favor.

CONFIRMATION OF NEXT MEETING:

The next meeting will be held on March 23, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

QUORUM:

Ms. McCord called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and determined there was a quorum with at least one member of the minority party being present. Mr. Dykes joined via phone.

WELCOME GUESTS:

Amy Sullivan, Virginia Green, Stephen Feryus, Khrystyna Bednarek, Peggy Hart, Rich Siejack, Loralyn Sisler, and Madison Varvaris from the staff were present for the meeting.

SWEARING IN OF NEW TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES:

Khrystyna Bedarek, Peggy Hart, and Madison Varvaris were sworn in by Ms. McCord.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mr. Price motioned to approve the January 27, 2022, regular session minutes and Mr. Richardson seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Mr. Richardson motioned to approve the closed meeting minutes from January 27, 2022, and Mr. Price seconded. The minutes were approved by the four members who were physically present. Mr. Dykes did not vote because he was attending the meeting via phone.

ADDITIONS OR CHANGES TO THE AGENDA:

There were no additions or changes to the agenda.

ELECTION OFFICE REPORT:

Ms. Taylor gave the Administration update. Discussion was as follows:

Ms. Taylor added that Evan Newcomb and Sarah Mohan were working with Amazon Web Services (AWS) on migrating the website. She announced today at 1:10pm the office was live on .gov. We are still in the testing phase and have not linked to the .info site yet.

Ms. Taylor gave the Staff update. Discussion was as follows:

Ms. Taylor added she reposted the Temporary Election Clerk position with the County. The 1-year knowledge of Election Law was removed from this post. Ms. Taylor felt it limited potential candidates during the last posting of the position and is not necessary for this position.

Mr. Wall gave the Election Operations update. Discussion was as follows:

Mr. Wall added the inventory was 98% complete and the pollbook printers have arrived at SBE but no delivery date has been set.

Ms. Slusar gave the Polling Place update. Discussion was as follows:

Mr. Richardson asked for clarification on the difference between a precinct and a vote center and Ms. Slusar explained the difference.

Ms. Sisler gave the Election Judge update. Discussion was as follows:

Ms. Sisler added they receive emails and calls daily with judges removing themselves from the election. She also stated the Meet & Greet classes scheduled for March had 25 applicants as of today.

Ms. Taylor gave the Redistricting update. Discussion was as follows:

Ms. Taylor explained there was talk of moving the Primary to July.

Ms. Taylor also expanded on the revelation of errors between the language of the Harford County Bill No. 21-025 and the Councilmanic map. These discoveries were made by Justin Wall and Richard Siejack while reviewing the new changes. She explained we cannot have an isolated precinct surrounded by other Councilmanic Districts. The current map contains two of them.

Ms. Taylor said the County has an employee who can help us with redistricting, starting next week.

Regarding merging precincts, Ms. Taylor explained currently we have 258 ballot styles and redistricting would add an additional 60. Merging precincts would reduce the amount of ballot

styles. Mr. Richardson asked if there was a policy for drawing precinct lines. Ms. Taylor replied the office draws them and the Board approves them. There is no limit on the number of voters per precinct but the location must be convenient for voters. Ms. Taylor said she not prepared at this time to present the proposed merged precincts.

Ms. Sullivan and Mr. Feryus gave the Voter Registration update.

Mr. Feryus gave the Candidate Filing update.

Mr. Siejack gave the Legislative update. Discussion was as follows:

Ms. McCord asked if we could canvass during Early Voting and Mr. Siejack replied that we cannot. We canvassed prior to Early Voting during the last election.

Mr. Richardson asked about the Election Judge Minimum Pay Bill. Ms. Taylor said the minimum requested is \$200 but our office pays more.

Ms. Taylor gave the Outreach update.

BOARD ATTORNEY'S REPORT:

Mr. Young explained a Campaign Chairman can be a candidate as long as they do not participate in the campaign. He said there is a fine line between Campaign Manager and Campaign Chairman.

Mr. Young explained the discrepancies in the County Council Redistricting Map and the written verbiage. There are several areas where the map and the written language do not match. The question being presented is which one do you go by – the map or the text? There are some areas which have become "islands" surrounded by other districts. This would make the map invalid because the districts are no longer congruent.

Mr. Young stated the County Charter does not say anything regarding this matter. He also questioned if the Legislation intended for the map to control or the language to control. In total there are five areas of contention regarding the map and the text.

The Charter states you have 70 days to pass a map. However, the last action taken on the map was January 4, 2022, the Council passed the map on December 7, 2021, and the effective date is March 8,2022. It is unknown which date is used to start the 70-day period.

Ms. Sisler asked if the Harford County Board of Elections would have to file a lawsuit and Mr. Young said that could be a possibility.

Mr. Campbell said the problem needs to be resolved to avoid a lawsuit.

Mr. Young stated the Board had a decision to make:

- 1. Go with the map
- 2. Go with the text
- 3. File suit with the County

Mr. Campbell said the Board has an obligation to ask the County to correct the issue. He requested the Board send a letter to the County showing the discrepancies and asking them to fix them. Mr. Campbell suggested the Board label them as "technical errors".

Mr. Richardson mad a motion for the Board President to send a letter to the Council President and County Executive describing the incongruencies and to ask for clarification and corrections. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion. All members approved this motion.

Mr. Young also noted the Office of Administrative Hearings has postponed the case with Ms. Livingston.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was none to report.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Sullivan presented renewal of 13 confidential voters for approval from the Board. Mr. Richardson asked for clarification regarding what a constituted a confidential and Ms. Sullivan responded. Mr. Price made a motion to accept the 13 confidential voters and Mr. Campbell approved. The four members in attendance approved. Mr. Dykes was via phone and was unable to review the candidates.

CONFIRMATION OF NEXT MEETING:

The next meeting will be held on March 23, 2022, at 5 p.m.

MEMBERS TIME:

Mr. Richardson wanted to verify all donations were to be reported after the donations were made. Ms. McCord explained the process.

HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS ELECTION OFFICE REPORT March 23, 2022

Administration:

- The Court of Special Appeals moved the election date to July 19th. The new dates for Early Voting are July 7th to July 14th.
- Three employees from the Office of the Legislative Auditors visited our office on March 15th to see how we have implemented the processes issued by the State Board.

Staff Updates:

• We hired two additional temporary Election Clerks. As of today we do not have a start date but it will be soon.

Election Operations:

- Electronic Pollbook training database has been tested and is ready for judge training
- CradlePoint routers' (used for VPN connection to SBE during Early Voting) firmware has been updated and is ready for the election.
- DS850 has been cleaned both physically and internally by ES&S and is ready for the election.
- Havre de Grace Municipal Election candidate list has been passed along to SBE; awaiting database from our Regional Manager.
- The six ballot drop box locations were approved by the State Board of Elections.

Polling Places:

• Due to the change in the election date, we are able to use Highlands Elementary School once again and are unable to use Jarrettsville Fire Hall for Early Voting. With the Board's approval we plan to use Jarrettsville Elementary School for the Primary Election.

Election Judges:

- We have developed a training schedule and webforms for the election judges. Training emails were sent the week of 02/21/22. Currently we have 482 judges signed up for training.
- With the primary election date pushed back, we have had approximately 60 judges resign. We are in the process of re-organizing the allocations and assignments.
- The judge manual has been finalized and approved by SBE. It will be sent to the printer very soon.
- We currently have 3 Meet & Greet classes scheduled for the end of March and have about 35 applicants.
- Daily judge work continues emailing potential new judges, importing judge data and changes, phone calls, mail, and emails.
- The current party affiliation statistics are Rep -272, Dem -359, Other -83







RESOLUTION OF THE HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, it is this 23rd day of March, 2022, by The Harford County Board of Elections (The Board) hereby **RESOLVED**, that it is the intention of The Board to comply with the laws, rules, and regulations of the United States and the State of Maryland;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the mission of The Board to ensure voter enfranchisement by providing an efficient and convenient way to participate in the voting process;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The Board recognizes changes made to the boundary lines of Congressional, Legislative, and Councilmanic Districts by each of the respective authorized bodies in performance of its Constitutional duties;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that House Bill 35/Senate Bill 158 passed on March 16, 2022, by the General Assembly of Maryland, requires, in part, in the 2022 statewide primary election and the 2022 statewide general election, in-person voting shall be conducted at a total number of precinct polling places that is at least equal to the total number of precinct polling places that were open for inperson voting on election day in the 2018 statewide general election;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board recognizes that the governor, by law, has 30 days to sign, veto, or take no action on legislation passed by the General Assembly of Maryland;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the staff has presented The Board with two precinct plans (Plan A and Plan B) have been proposed for approval by this Board and are attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that both Plan A and Plan B meet the criteria set forth hereinabove, and that Plan A is hereby **APPROVED** going forward, unless and until, the aforesaid provisions in House Bill 35/Senate Bill 158 become law, then, in that case Plan B is hereby necessarily **APPROVED** for the 2022 primary and general elections.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

MD Election Law Code Ann. §2-303. Precincts.

- (a) In general. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, as it deems it expedient for the convenience of voters, a local board may:
 - (i) Create and alter the boundaries for precincts in the county;
 - (ii) Designate the location for polling places in any election district, ward, or precinct in the county; and
 - (iii) Combine or abolish precincts.

MD Election Law Code Ann. §10-101. In general.

- (a) Designation of polling places In general. (1) Each local board shall designate a polling place that meets the requirements of this subsection for each precinct in the county as established by the local board in accordance with Title 2 of this article.
 - (2) Each polling place shall:
 - (i) provide an environment that is suitable to the proper conduct of an election;
 - (ii) be located as conveniently as practicable for the majority of registered voters assigned to that polling place;
 - (iii) except as authorized in paragraph (4) of this subsection, be in a public building;
 - (iv) be in the precinct that it serves unless no suitable location for a polling place can be found within that precinct, in which case the board may establish the polling place in an adjacent precinct; and
 - (v) whenever practicable, be selected and arranged to avoid architectural and other barriers that impede access or voting by elderly and physically disabled voters.

COMAR 33.15.01.01 – Maps and Descriptions.

- A. Board to Prepare. Each local board shall prepare, or arrange for the preparation of, and make available to the public maps and descriptions that delineate all wards, precincts, and districts that are wholly or partly within its area.
- B. Required Clarity. Each map and description shall provide a delineation of boundaries that is:
 - (1) Clear and concise; and
 - (2) Easily understandable by members of the general public.

COMAR 33.15.02.01 - Scope.

- A. This chapter applies whenever a local board:
 - (1) Creates a new precinct; or
 - (2) Changes precinct boundaries.
- B. For a special election, a local board may combine polling places established for regularly scheduled elections.

COMAR 33.15.02.02 – Precinct To Lie Wholly within District.

A precinct may not be created, and the boundaries of a precinct may not be changed, so as to cross any district boundary.

COMAR 33.15.02.03 - Resolution Required.

- A. In General. A local board may create a new precinct or change precinct boundaries only by adoption of a written resolution.
- B. Contents. The resolution under §A of this regulation shall:
 - (1) State the purpose of the change;
 - (2) Contain a written description of all precinct boundaries; and
 - (3) Be accompanied by a map of the area involved.
- C. Filing with State Board. Within 5 days after a resolution is adopted, the election director shall notify the State Administrator in writing of the new precinct or changed precinct boundaries.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To comply with MD Election Law and corresponding regulations (election districts, precincts, polling places, & maps).
- 2. To enhance the voter experience through efficiency and convenience (room size, location, parking, ease of access, reduce wait times, and maintain social distancing, if necessary).
- 3. Minimize travel distance for redistricted/relocated voters.
- 4. Maximize use of public facilities security, reliability, and access.
- 5. Minimum disruption to historically disenfranchised areas.
- 6. Efficient use of resources election judge recruitment and retention, EDSS, equipment & staff.
- 7. Reduce ballot styles (Election Day and Early Voting) prevent disenfranchising voters.
- 8. Improve speed of election night reporting.
- 9. Fiscal responsibility reduce private location use, judge/labor cost, materials, and delivery.
- 10. Additional equipment to each polling location/increase efficiency of voting process and more surplus available, if needed.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

MD Election Law Code Ann. §2-303. Precincts.

- (a) In general. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, as it deems it expedient for the convenience of voters, a local board may:
 - (i) Create and alter the boundaries for precincts in the county;
 - (ii) Designate the location for polling places in any election district, ward, or precinct in the county; and
 - (iii) Combine or abolish precincts.

MD Election Law Code Ann. §10-101. In general.

- (a) Designation of polling places In general. (1) Each local board shall designate a polling place that meets the requirements of this subsection for each precinct in the county as established by the local board in accordance with Title 2 of this article.
 - (2) Each polling place shall:
 - (i) provide an environment that is suitable to the proper conduct of an election;
 - (ii) be located as conveniently as practicable for the majority of registered voters assigned to that polling place;
 - (iii) except as authorized in paragraph (4) of this subsection, be in a public building;
 - (iv) be in the precinct that it serves unless no suitable location for a polling place can be found within that precinct, in which case the board may establish the polling place in an adjacent precinct; and
 - (v) whenever practicable, be selected and arranged to avoid architectural and other barriers that impede access or voting by elderly and physically disabled voters.

COMAR 33.15.01.01 – Maps and Descriptions.

- A. Board to Prepare. Each local board shall prepare, or arrange for the preparation of, and make available to the public maps and descriptions that delineate all wards, precincts, and districts that are wholly or partly within its area.
- B. Required Clarity. Each map and description shall provide a delineation of boundaries that is:
 - (1) Clear and concise; and
 - (2) Easily understandable by members of the general public.

COMAR 33.15.02.01 - Scope.

- A. This chapter applies whenever a local board:
 - (1) Creates a new precinct; or
 - (2) Changes precinct boundaries.
- B. For a special election, a local board may combine polling places established for regularly scheduled elections.

COMAR 33.15.02.02 – Precinct To Lie Wholly within District.

A precinct may not be created, and the boundaries of a precinct may not be changed, so as to cross any district boundary.

COMAR 33.15.02.03 - Resolution Required.

- A. In General. A local board may create a new precinct or change precinct boundaries only by adoption of a written resolution.
- B. Contents. The resolution under §A of this regulation shall:
 - (1) State the purpose of the change;
 - (2) Contain a written description of all precinct boundaries; and
 - (3) Be accompanied by a map of the area involved.
- C. Filing with State Board. Within 5 days after a resolution is adopted, the election director shall notify the State Administrator in writing of the new precinct or changed precinct boundaries.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To comply with MD Election Law and corresponding regulations (election districts, precincts, polling places, & maps).
- 2. To enhance the voter experience through efficiency and convenience (room size, location, parking, ease of access, reduce wait times, and maintain social distancing, if necessary).
- 3. Minimize travel distance for redistricted/relocated voters.
- 4. Maximize use of public facilities security, reliability, and access.
- 5. Minimum disruption to historically disenfranchised areas.
- 6. Efficient use of resources election judge recruitment and retention, EDSS, equipment & staff.
- 7. Reduce ballot styles (Election Day and Early Voting) prevent disenfranchising voters.
- 8. Improve speed of election night reporting.
- 9. Fiscal responsibility reduce private location use, judge/labor cost, materials, and delivery.
- 10. Additional equipment to each polling location/increase efficiency of voting process and more surplus available, if needed.
