December 11, 2024

Administration:

- Working on performance evaluations for the staff.
- Five staff members helped Frederick County with the countywide recount.
- One staff member went to Prince George's County to help process their provisional ballots.
- The Comprehensive Audit will be completed tomorrow.
- SBE has asked us if we will pilot a Risk Limiting Audit (RLA) on December 18th.
- SBE has asked Amy to be on the subcommittee for the new Voter Registration software and for me to be on one for the new voting system.

Staff Updates:

- We have two positions posted for hire.

Election Operations

- All equipment and supplies have been returned.
- We are waiting on SBE to release the equipment so we can start the post-election maintenance.
- Election documents have been organized and archived.
- There is a high probability that we will be required to have a 5th Early Voting site for 2026.

Election Judges:

- The election judge payroll was submitted to the County on November 22nd.
- They are unpacking and receiving all the paperwork.
- A survey was sent out to all the judges who worked during Early Voting and Election Day. We are reviewing their responses.
