BOARD ATTORNEY'S REPORT:

Mr. Young stated the President's Order on Elections Lawsuit is ongoing, it now includes 16 States. Also, The Maryland State Board of Elections responded to the Department of Justice's voter data request by asking them for more information.

OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

Polling Place Change: Ms. Taylor requested the reversal of a previous polling place change (voted on at the January 29, 2025 meeting) due to the Highlands School no longer being available. Ms. Taylor also presented to the Board reasons to combine two other precincts. Ms. Bracknell asked for a reversal of the motion to merge Precincts 1-13 (Riverside Community Center) and 1-14 (Church Creek Elementary School) making 1-13 (Riverside Community Center) a polling location again and combining Precincts 1-08/1-09 (The Highlands School) with 1-14 (Church Creek Elementary School). Mr. Campbell made the motion, and Ms. McMillan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by the rest of the Board Members who were present at the meeting.

Approval of Election Plan: Ms. Taylor presented the 2026 Election Plan; the plan includes Early Voting locations, Drop Box locations, and Election Day polling locations. Ms. Bracknell asked for a motion to approve the 2026 Election Plan. Ms. McMillan made the motion, and Mr. Price seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by the rest of the Board Members who were present at the meeting.

Approval of Confidential Voters: Ms. Taylor requested approval from the board to change a voter's record to "Confidential" status. Upon review, Ms. Bracknell asked for a motion. Mr. Campbell made a motion to approve the confidentiality request. Mr. Price seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by the rest of the Board Members who were present at the meeting.

The next meeting scheduled is September 24, 2025 at 5:00pm.

Administration:

- MVA surrender letters
- Began refresher training with all office staff on opening and closing the election equipment
- Voter registration volunteer training with the Democratic Central Committee and with the League of Women voters this past month
- We began advertising our open house on October 8th from 3:00pm to 6:00pm.

Staff Updates:

- None currently

Election Operations

- Checked and adjusted contents of supplies in black equipment carts (electrical bag, sign pole bag contents, etc.)
- Received new polling place signage bags and have been packing the signs in them to store in the transportation carts neatly (1-2-3 signs, No Electioneering signs, privacy panels, etc.)
- Designing and ordering signs to be placed at the two polling locations we will not be using in 2026
- Designing and ordering signs for McFaul and Havre de Grace activity centers.
- Filmed "Cancelling a VAC in the Pollbook" judge training video
- We received the ballot for Bel Air and Aberdeen. They are in the proofing stage.
- Continued regular-interval equipment battery charging

Election Judges:

- Meet and Greet sessions for new election judges have begun and are continuing. We have had approximately forty-six attendees to date.
- The returning judge availability survey was emailed on September 8th. So far, we have received over six hundred responses.
- Researching new judge supplies to streamline returning election documents
- Prepared judge training schedule.
- Planning a Same Day Registration judge workshop to be held in November.
- We are continuing to review/update files, forms, and Smartsheets in preparation for the 2026 election
