HARFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS OFFICE REPORT December 3, 2025

Administration:

- We have had a few Risk Limiting Audit (RLA) discussion with SBE, MAEO and staff. MAEO has decided to create a workgroup.
- Met with a rep from Gramophone to install speakers in the training room ceiling.
- Nate installed electronic calendars in Deputy's and Director's offices.
- The FY27 budget was submitted to the county budget office on October 23, 2025.
- MAEO and SBE met with Sen. Kagan to discuss her proposed election legislation.

Staff Updates:

Election Operations

- Completed the Aberdeen and Bel Air elections.
 - Aberdeen turnout: 991 out of 12,802 (7.7%)
 - Bel Air turnout: 922 out of 8,159 (11.3%)
- Conducted testing of the DS850 High Speed Scanner to prepare for next year's RLAs.
- Continuing regular equipment charging & maintenance

Election Judges:

- We held two Same Day Registration workshops, and a total of thirty-five judges attended those sessions.
- The final availability survey has been sent out, and we are updating our active judge list. We had over 730 responses from the survey.
- We have wrapped up the Meet and Greet meetings for this year.
- We have added additional technology to help with department collaboration on training materials, forms, and calendars.
- We are sending out a Winter Newsletter.
