February 18, 2026

Administration:

- We received the pricing on the new pollbooks and voting equipment. An amendment for the FY27 budget was sent to the county.
- We are hoping to know which vendor was selected for the new voting equipment by next week.

Staff Updates:

- We are waiting for our two contractual pins be posted on the State of Maryland's website.

Election Operations

- We conducted the first phase of SBE's RLA audit test - scanned ~2500 24PP ballots across 8 randomly selected Election Day polling places, 1 Early Voting site, and the Mail-In Ballot canvass.
- The SBE annual inventory audit was completed in four days.
- Received shipment of new CMOS batteries for Pollbooks - we replaced all the old internal CMOS batteries in our spare units.
- Continuing regular equipment charging & maintenance
- New "Future Voter" sticker

Election Judges:

- Judge Manual contract has been approved, and files have been sent to the printer.
- Starting to pack judge supplies.
- Continuing to review training materials.
- Meet and Greets have resumed.
- Break down by party of people who have applied to be an election judge:
 - Democratic - 344
 - Republican - 303
 - Unaffiliated - 145
 - Other - 8

- In addition to regular daily work, we have received three ERIC reports; NCOA (National Change of Address), Cross State, and In-State Updates.

Legislation

- The General Assembly session is in full swing and the deadline for bills to be introduced normally in the Senate has already passed (2/9). The deadline for introducing bills normally to the House is on 2/13.
- As of writing on 2/10, 83 election bills have been introduced to the legislature. While not all bills fall under the purview or responsibilities of Local Boards of Elections, there are several bills that MAEO has been tracking:
 - SB0029/HB0044 Election Law-Petitions and Ballot Questions-Contents, Plain Language Requirement, and Procedures mandates that all ballot question summaries and petition signature pages be written in "plain language" that is easily understood by voters, specifically prohibiting the use of legal jargon, double negatives, and the passive voice. Passed and moved to the House for first reading.
 - SB0132/ HB0156 Election Law- Affiliating with a Party and Voting- Unaffiliated Voters-This bill allows unaffiliated voters to affiliate with a political party at an early voting center during a primary election and immediately cast a provisional ballot for that party.

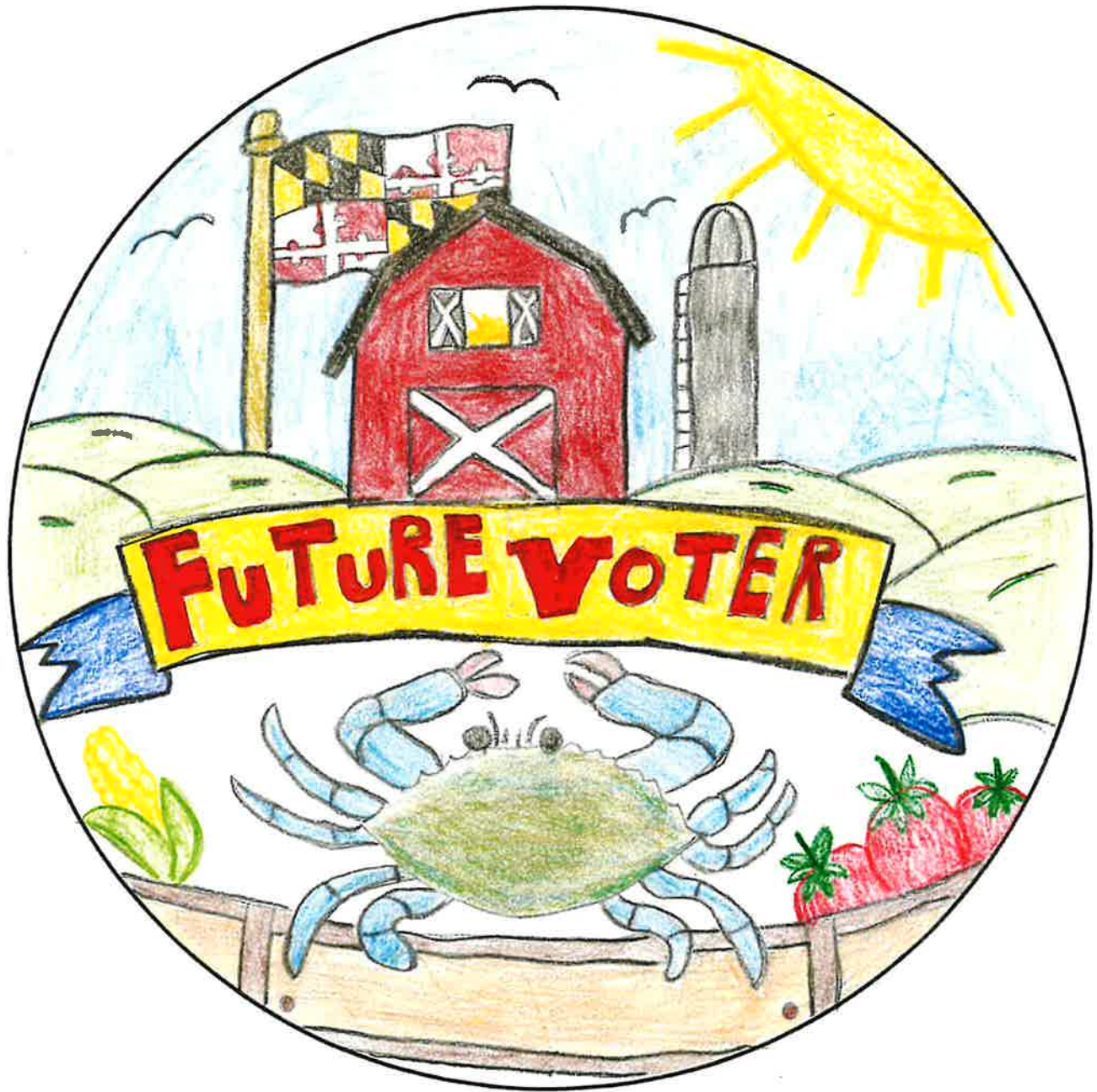
